WHAT IS FUTRIX CONSOLE?

Futrix Console is used to administer the Futrix Application Server via the familiar point and click interface. This gives the administrator control over the functionality and information delivered to the user. Using Futrix Console the Administrator also manages data registration and security, as well as the configuration of user access and accounts.

KEY BENEFITS

Control access. Administrators can configure user accounts to allow them to access relevant information for their role. A simple data registration process allows Administrators to make data available without the user needing to know how and where the information is stored. As a user becomes more adept at using Futrix they can be given access to more tools and data.

Security. Access is centrally managed, ensuring the right level of information is made available at an individual user level. Futrix can also synchronise with SAS user security metadata to provide one single source of security information.

Rapid data distribution. Administrators can add subjects, dimensions and measures to keep up with your business needs. Futrix has a built-in framework that allows you to change the processes and functionality to suit your business. The links are created via the Console to provide a consistent and simplified view of data in a business subject area. Administrators can quickly create multi-dimensional data structures to improve the performance of user reports.

Optimise the Performance of Futrix. The Console automatically tracks how your data is used. This information feeds into the built-in optimisation technology to continuously improve the performance of Futrix.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Futrix Administrators configure the integration of Futrix with SAS BI Server functionality, including use of metadata from the SAS Open Metadata repository and multidimensional data made available by SAS OLAP Server.
